Duties of this position primarily focus on **general chemistry** and other laboratory courses (e.g. general, organic, analytic/instrumental, physical, and inorganic chemistry laboratories for undergraduates), and to support the events/courses under all-time English-lecturing policy of NSYSU. Excellent English skills for teaching are required, and will be carefully evaluated during the recruiting process. International candidates who have no Taiwan citizenship are strongly encouraged to apply. Candidates with research specialty in in all fields of **chemistry** are welcome. Responsibility includes a minimum teaching load of 9 credit hours for each semester, according to the University policy. Personal office space will be provided; the salary would be commensurate with the tenure track professors. Several public laboratories are available in our department if the recruited applicant requests.

In addition, mentorship and student recruiting activities (both domestic or international ones) for the department are anticipated. Neither administrative nor research duties are associated with this position, however, research grant application to the Ministry of Science and Technology is permitted for non-tenure-track faculty.

Ph.D. degree in chemistry. Post-doctoral experience for more than one year is preferred. Either native Chinese- or English-speaking candidates are welcome to apply, but **ONLY** candidates with English-lecturing capability will be accepted.
